Eligibility: Open Competition. Novice contestants from all states are welcome. All contestants must be currently registered and insured with one of the following national organizations: USA Judo (USJI), USJF, or USJA (membership in USA Judo will be available at the tournament site during registration). See below for age/weight eligibility.

Insurance Note: For insurance liability purposes, contestants must provide proof of current registration and insurance with one of the above listed national organizations. If the registration card is lost, Colorado Judo League can only verify USA Judo (USJI) registration locally.

Awards: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in all divisions.

Rules and Methods of Elimination: Current IJF rules as modified below for local competition will be in effect.

1. If a modified safety area size around the competition area is used, 1994 IJF rules with regard to boundaries will be used.

2. Pre-2004 rules regarding medical attention will be used.

3. Match times: Senior categories (male and female): 5 minutes;
Juniors and Masters (male and female): 3 minutes.

4. Junior Categories: Chokes and Armlocks NOT allowed.

5. Senior and Masters Categories: Armlocks NOT Allowed

6. Golden Score will be in effect for all categories.

The following elimination system will be used:

1. More than 5 competitors: Modified double elimination

2. 5 or fewer competitors: Round Robin elimination

Start Time: Juniors: Roll Call – 10:00am
Start Time – immediately following roll call
Seniors and Masters: Roll Call – 12:00pm
Start Time – immediately following completion of junior categories but no earlier than 1:00pm

Categories: Senior Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are at least 17 years old and who are lower than brown belt (sankyu) rank.
Masters Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are 30 years old or older and who are lower than brown belt (sankyu) rank.
Junior Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are between 5 and 16 years of age on the day of the tournament who are white and yellow belts only.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the 2006 Colorado State Judo Championships and related events and activities of United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Colorado Judo League, Denver Judo, LLC, and Flood Middle School, I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination scoring systems to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and sever social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inaction, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules for the sports of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Colorado Judo League, Denver Judo, LLC, and Flood Middle School, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereafter referred to as "releasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability or death and damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
