Entry Fees: **Save \$5.00 by registering early on-line! On-Line Entry Fee is \$20.00 before November 12. After November 12 but before November 17, on-line entry fee is \$25.00. Credit Cards are accepted on-line via PayPal. Go to www.denverjudo.com to register! On-line entry closes at midnight, November 16, 2006.**
Entry fee by mail is **\$25.00** for each division entered. Entries received after November 12, 2006 will be **\$30.00** for each division entered. Competitors 15 years and older and brown belt rank or higher may compete in their age/weight division and/or a senior division; competitors 30 years and older may compete in the Masters Category and/or the Senior Category. A separate entry form and entry fee is required for each division entered.

Eligibility: Open competition. Contestants from all states are welcome. All contestants must be currently registered and insured with one of the following national organizations: USA Judo (NGB, USJI), USJF, or USJA (Members in USA Judo will be available at the tournament site during registration.) See below for age/weight eligibility.

Insurance Note: For insurance liability purposes, contestants must provide proof of current registration **and insurance** with one of the above listed national organizations. If the registration card is lost, Colorado Judo League can only verify USA Judo (USJI) registration locally.

Awards: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in all divisions. Team Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.

Rules and Methods of Elimination:

- Current IJF rules as modified below for local competition will be in effect.
1. If a modified safety area size around the competition area is used, 1994 IJF rules with regard to boundaries will be used.
 2. Pre-2004 rules regarding medical attention will be used.
 3. Match times: Senior and Juvenile C categories (male and female): 5 minutes; Juniors and Masters: 3 minutes.
 4. Junior Bantam and Intermediate Categories: Chokes and Armlocks NOT allowed.
 5. Junior Juvenile A&B categories and Senior and Masters Novice Categories: Armlocks NOT allowed.
- The following elimination system will be used:
1. More than 5 competitors: Modified double elimination
 2. 5 or fewer competitors: Round Robin elimination

Junior Categories: 9:30 am
 Senior and Masters Categories: Not before 12:30 pm

Categories:

Senior Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are at least 15 years old. For those below 17 years old, minimum of brown belt rank is required.
 Senior Novice Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are 17 years and older who are below Brown Belt (Sankyu).
 Masters Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are 30 years and older.
 Masters Novice Divisions: Open to male and female competitors who are 30 years and older and below Brown Belt (Sankyu)
 Junior Boys and Girls Divisions: Athletes ages 5 – 19 years may enter the junior category.
 Junior Novice Divisions: Athletes ages 5 – 16 years and who are **WHITE or YELLOW BELTS ONLY** may enter the junior novice divisions.
Athletes below orange belt may compete in EITHER the advanced division OR the novice division but not both!

Weights:

Novice Junior, Senior, and Masters Divisions will be determined after weigh-in based on the number of participants. We will endeavor to use the weights listed below as much as possible.

NOTE: For the Juvenile A&B category, an attempt will be made to keep contestants ages 13-14 years, and 15-16 years separated, *if possible*. All age/weight categories may be modified depending on the weight range of the contestants entered and after considering fairness and safety of the competitors. Coaches, competitors, and/or parents will be advised if any published weight category is changed.
Masters Competitors: If possible, masters will be broken down by age.

Special Rules:

1. A competitor who **voluntarily** enters an age or weight division that is higher than his or her normal division must abide by the rules of that division. Example: a competitor whose age would normally not allow the use of chokes (or armlocks), is subject to choking (or armlock) techniques if he or she **voluntarily** enters a division where chokes (or armlocks) are allowed.
2. Contestants may enter only one division per category. Examples:
 - a. Contestants who are 15 or 16 years old and brown belt rank or higher may enter both Junior and Senior categories.
 - b. Contestants who are 30 years and above may compete in both Masters and Senior categories.
 Contestants who complete in two categories must submit two entry forms and pay two entry fees.

**Any situation not covered by the above will be decided by the tournament director after considering the safety of, and fairness to, all contestants.
 Decisions by the tournament director are final!**

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the 2006 6th Annual Denver Classic Judo Tournament and related events and activities of United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Colorado Judo League, Denver Judo, LLC, and Englewood High School, I hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination scoring systems to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and sever social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inaction, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules for the sports of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo, Inc., United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Colorado Judo League, Denver Judo, LLC, and Englewood High School, together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereafter referred to as "releasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability or death and damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
