Colorado Athletes won 6 gold medals, 4 silver, and 3 bronze medals at the 2010 U.S. Judo Federation and U.S. Judo Association Junior National Championship July 4-5 in Irvine California. The event was attended by 872 athletes, ages 8-19 from all over the United States.

George Truong, of Ju Shin Kan Judo Club in Colorado Springs was a double gold medalist in the 15-16 and 17-19 year old division. Athletes from Ju Shin Kan also finished first among Colorado clubs with 5 medals (4 gold and 1 bronze) followed closely by Hyland Hills Judo Club in Westminster with 4 medals (2 gold and 2 silver).
